**Board of Directors Transition.** Board Member at Large Anne Green has resigned from the Board, in anticipation of her upcoming move. Thank you so much Anne for all you have done for UUFN. The Board has appointed Peter Hartranft to the Board to finish the remainder of Anne's term, through June 30, 2020. Thank you Peter for your willingness to serve.

**2020/2021 Budget.** Your Board and Finance Committee are busy planning for our next fiscal year. For the remainder of this 2019/2020 fiscal year, we anticipate reduced Share the Plate contributions and the loss of the \$18,000 planned income from the spring auction. We continue to pay our staff (our biggest expense). Based on today's information, with over 30 members not yet pledging, we have to anticipate reduced pledge income, in addition to reduced Share the Plate income, as we create the budget.

Please, if you are going to pledge this year (and it is a requirement for all members), **please pledge now.** We need to know how much income to expect for next year – this will greatly impact our plans for the future. And if you are able, and you haven't increased your pledge in a few years, this might be the year to do so. It would be greatly appreciated.
