Preamble

The mission of the UUFN is to be a community of spiritual seekers inspired to create a just and compassionate world. To this end, the Labyrinth Team offers labyrinth walks, labyrinth workshops, and labyrinth worship services as time and needs allow. Walking the labyrinth is a meditative and peaceful spiritual practice that adds to the variety and diversity of spirituality at the Fellowship. The Labyrinth Team also makes these walks open to the public so that the community can be involved and can have this experience as well. This is an important part of the Fellowship's mission as spiritual seekers.

Responsibilities

The Labyrinth Team conducts labyrinth walks, labyrinth workshops and labyrinth worship services, and maintains our three canvas labyrinths and other supplies needed to create a meditative mood in the labyrinth space, such as CDs for sound, candles (both regular and electric) and other items that decorate our directional altars.

The Labyrinth Team coordinates with the Worship Team as needed for planning labyrinth walks around events such as New Year's Eve, phases of the moon, or seasons of the year, such as an equinox or solstice.

The Labyrinth Team coordinates with the Religious Education (RE) Team as needed for RE programming.
